Many thanks to those who have been spreading the salt on the roads. It has already been really appreciated over NewYear around Guineaford Bridge, creating a safer road to travel on early in the morning. Thank you and thank you our key workers.

There is a supply of road salt, in bags, available for use on the highways. Please contact Cllr David Chugg on 07774 750923, Marwood Parish Council if you need salt for the highways in your area.

DO PLEASE TAKE THE UTMOST CARE WHEN TRAVELLING ON THE ROADS. THERE HAVE BEEN SEVERAL ACCIDENTS IN MARWOOD RECENTLY. The forecast for January is COLD! The school area has a good supply of salt now but there are a significant number of vehicles using the minor roads - please take care. 'The Braunton Neighbourhood Police Newsletter January 2021' has lots of useful information. Also remember not to give information about yourself to anyone, especially those wanting to give 'fake' vaccinations!
