



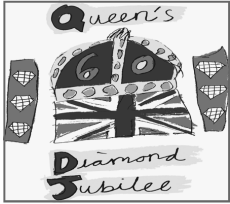

Marwood School

We have a very busy May to look forward to - Children in year 6 will be taking their SATs; they have all been working hard and deserve every success. The children in Class 3 are going to the climbing centre at South Molton, now called Rock and Rapid, for a three day residential. On the 21st May the whole school is going to Braunton to join in the celebration of the Olympic torch procession. During May teams are going to representing the school in netball, football and cricket and classes will be having tennis coaching.

During this month we will be planning and rehearsing our Jubilee events for Friday 1st June. Thanks to the generosity of the Parish and District Councils all of the children will receive a commemorative coin and enjoy a celebration tea. Parents, friends and members of the community are very welcome to join us at school from 1.30 p.m. To be entertained with music, singing, dancing and possibly even join in some games! The children are going to dress for the occasion and the school association will be selling refreshments to parents and visitors.

There is a **meeting of the Jubilee Committee** at school on **Tuesday 15th May at 7:00pm** to finalise the community and school events.

Marwood School in partnership with Devon Primary School Centred Initial Teacher Training (DPSCITT) has been designated as a 'Teaching School' by the National College of School Leaders. There are just over 200 Teaching Schools in the country with the aim of developing innovative practice in staff training, initial teacher training, classroom practice and school leadership.

Report of Marwood Parish Council Meeting 29 March 2012

Present: Cllrs Mrs S Darling, C Spear, G Tamlyn, J Glanville

Apologies: Cllrs. T Bigge, C Latham, C Wallis, R May, M Darling

In Attendance: Cllr Mrs A Davis, M J Measures and one member of the public

County Councillor Report: Cllr Mrs Davis reported on the changes to some of the responsibilities of certain County Councillors. Members congratulated her on her appointment as Lead Member for sections of Education.

Finance: Invoices were agreed for payment and the Clerk informed Members the DCC has given a grant of £2000 for next year the P3 Scheme (Parish Paths Partnership). The Clerk will attend a meeting in the Civic Centre regarding the future of grants from NDC.

Planning Matters:

53631. Barn opposite Greenhill Bungalow, conversion of barn to form one unit of holiday accommodation. Recommend: Approval

53758. Abandoned Cottage, Varley PRIXFORD, retrospective application for the siting of a static caravan for holiday letting use. Recommend: Refusal.

Reports from Councillors: Cllr Mrs Darling had attended a meeting of the Community Hall Management Committee and said there is some progress and the Committee is looking at a reduced specification.

Diamond Jubilee Celebrations: Cllr Mrs Darling attended a meeting of the Jubilee Committee and reported that there are several activities planned. The Clerk will contact the Council's insurers to confirm cover. The cost of the commemorative coins will be met by Marwood Matters and the Parish Council. The Parish Council will also cover any additional cost up to £200.
