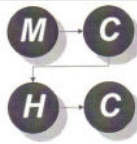

Parish Council Report

Report of the Parish Council Meeting: Tuesday 18th June 2013

Present: Cllrs C Latham, G Tamlyn, R May, C Spear, J Glanville, T Bigge, M Darling.

Apologies: Cllrs Mrs S Darling, C Wallis. PCSO Kingdon

In Attendance: Cllr Mrs A Davis, Cllr F Tucker, M J Measures, 13 members of the public. In the absence of Cllr Mrs Darling (Chairman), Cllr Latham (Vice-Chairman) took the meeting.

Disclosable Pecuniary Interests: Cllr Latham (55683 planning)

The Minutes of the Annual General Meeting & Parish Council Meeting 9 May 2013 were agreed and signed as a true record.

Police Report: In the absence of PCSO Kingdon, the Clerk said no crimes have been reported in the last month. Updates on speeding issues are on the Neighbourhood Police Site. Guineaford and PRIXFORD are two areas highlighted. Monitoring will also take place in Muddiford.

County and District Councillor Reports: Cllr Tucker mentioned the government guidelines concerning wind turbine installations; there are new Heads of Departments at NDC: the application for the Atlantic Array is now being considered. Cllr Mrs Davis highlighted the national success for Devon Libraries; DCC expands the innovative project to help residents affected by welfare reform; Council Tax scam warning as fraudsters target North Devon; DCC Cabinet confirmed Cllr Mrs Davis responsible for improving health and well-being; Cllr Mrs Chugg (Braunton) elected as Council's Vice-Chairman.

Planning Applications: 55683 - *Honeywell Farm, Muddiford. Erection of single wind turbine, height 61m together with associated works.* Cllr Latham registered a Disclosable Pecuniary Interest and left the meeting. Cllr Mrs Davis left the meeting. Cllr Spear was elected to act as Chairman. Standing Orders were suspended to allow members of the public to speak. The applicant read a short statement in support of his application and four members of the public read prepared statements opposing the application. The Chairman thanked everyone for their input and Standing Orders were reinstated. Following discussion it was agreed to **Recommend: Refusal** (noise, visual impact, unsuitable location) voting 6 For, 1 Against) The Chairman thanked members of the public for attending and 12 left the meeting. Cllr Latham continued as Chairman. 55768 - *Whiddon Farm, Milltown. Reserved Matters application for erection of one agricultural worker's dwelling (outline planning permission 49985)* **Recommend : Approval**
Finance: Balance at 18 June 2013 is £10,438.92 (includes £2,600 Parish Path Scheme) Grants of £250 each were agreed for Marwood Methodist Church and St Michaels and All Saints (for cemetery maintenance); Clerk's salary/admin agreed
Reports from Councillors: *Parish Footpaths:* Cllr Wallis will contact DCC regarding *footpath 28*. *Highways:* Cllr Latham has reported the location of some pot-holes. He was asked to find out how long the single-phase traffic lights will remain on the B3230. *Community Hall:* Cllr May said the Management Committee had been meeting and they are waiting for the Trustees to meet to arrange the AGM. The Clerk informed Members that the Trustees would be meeting immediately after the Parish Meeting. *Rural Alliance:* Cllr Glanville said the last meeting discussed the new broadband and said Marwood will be the first to receive it. The next meeting will be attended by a DCC highways Officer.

Parish Council Minutes/Continued:

Additional Items: The Clerk informed Members of the progress of the TAP Fund as he is still in contact with the four other Parishes involved. The Clerk read an e-mail form NDC (received that afternoon) concerning the Community Right to Bid as part of the Localism Act 2011. " A nomination has been received by NDC from an unincorporated local group in respect of a property in Marwood Parish, The Ring O'Bells, PRIXFORD". The Parish Council has been asked to comment. "NDC has eight weeks in which to make a decision on whether or not to include the property on the register of community interests".

This matter will be discussed at the next Parish Council Meeting on 11 July 2013.

The meeting closed at 21.00
