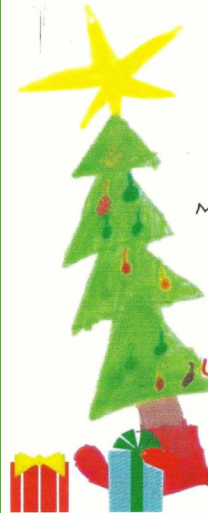

Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting 11 October 2018 Minutes were agreed and signed as a true record.

Police Report The Clerk sent Members a copy of the Police Report which showed two crimes of criminal damage, two thefts and one assault.

Reports from County and District Councillors Cllr Mrs Davis reported that Devon County Council Cabinet is considering proposals to save the Council £5million in the remainder of this financial year, including a two-month delay on recruitment to all non-essential job vacancies, stopping non-essential overtime, ceasing conference attendance, hospitality and travel allowances (unless externally funded). A361: overnight closures (19.00 – 07.00) are due on the section near Tiverton from 19 November to 25 November. *A copy of the full report is attached to the Minutes*

No report from Cllr Tucker.

Finance Invoices agreed for payment: C F Wallis £100.00 (Oct); Admin/Accom. £54.0 (Sep/Oct); NDC £457.30; Marwood Matters £125.00 (printing of Marwood Matters); Marwood Matters £60.00 (domain). Balance at 8 November 2018 is £7810.92.

Cllr Mrs Davis left the meeting at 20.05

Members discussed the proposed precept for 2019/2020. The Clerk reminded Members that there will be elections in May next year for District Councillors and Parish Councillors. Following further discussion it was agreed to recommend no increase in the Parish precept and to request a sum of £750.00 towards the cost of the election.

Cllr Wallis left the meeting at 20.25

The Council agreed to take delivery of 40x25kg bags of road salt which will be delivered to Kilbarri House, Kings Heanton. Members of the public will be able to obtain bags for use only on Parish roads.

Planning Matters 5574. *Erection of three units of holiday accommodation, Blakewell Trout Farm.* Members expressed concern about the possible increase in traffic and the poor entrance. **Recommend: Approval**

65644. *Creation of off-road parking area to front of dwelling, Combe Brook, Guineaford.* **Recommend: Approval**

65686. *Construction of slurry storage lagoon together with erection of security fencing, Lower Metcombe Farm Marwood.* **Recommend: Approval**

65363. *Extensions and alterations to dwelling, Kilbarri House Kings Heanton* **Recommend: Approval**

65798. *Extension to dwelling, Muddipuddle Farm Muddiford.* **Recommend: Approval**

Members agreed to discuss this late application

65653. *Conversion of water tank (reservoir) and the land within its curtilage, Whiddon Service Reservoir Muddiford.*

Members expressed concern regarding the differences between the application and the drawings; no external dimensions or levels; questioned the foul drainage assessment. More comments and questions were raised and a full response will be made to ND Planning Department.

Traffic Calming Scheme, Prieford. The Clerk read a response to Members from Brian Hensley, DCC Development Manager stating that Paul Young will be liaising with NDC Planning, the developer and the Parish Council. The Clerk commented that this matter has been on-going for about two years and is constantly being moved from one DCC Section to another.

Cllr Chugg returned to the meeting at 20.31

On-going Matters Footpath 45. Cllr Sue Button is collecting and collating the completed questionnaires before making an application to Devon County Council

Reports from Councillors Parish Footpaths. No report Highways/Transport. It was agreed to clean all the name/road signs in the Parish, eg. Guineaford, Prieford, Muddiford.
