MARWOOD LADIES

Our May meeting was held in the Magnolia Room at North Devon Hospice, Deer Park, Newport and included a tour of the Hospice. Stephen Roberts, the Chief Executive, explained that thanks to the generosity of the people of North Devon, 2014 is the charity's 30th year of "being there for all the family"; providing specialist care and support to those with a life-threatening illness and to their loved ones.

It costs £4 million each year to provide the services. The area covered is 800 square miles and the nursing team travelled over 50,000 miles visiting people in their homes. Over 2580 people are cared for each year and the Hospice to Home service has helped prevent over 170 unplanned admissions to hospital.

The 5th June meeting is in the church hall and will be a talk from Richard Prowse, the Chairman and Alan Dodd the Theatres Director of the North Devon Theatres Trust which runs the Queens and Landmark Theatres.

**Report of the Public/Annual General Meeting
Marwood Parish Council 15 May 2014**

In Attendance: Cllr Mrs A Davis, Cllr F Tucker, PCSO Kingdon, M J Measures, one member of the public.

Mrs June Tamlyn asked Members when the road signs and markings will be delivered. Mrs Tamlyn was part of a group (with Cllr Mrs Davis, two DCC Highways Officers, a road safety officer, two Parish Councillors and the Parish Clerk) who walked parts of the Parish roads last December. The Clerk said the signs had been ordered in January this year and after several telephone calls, South West Highways confirmed on Monday that the signs were made but could not be put up as they are waiting for an Order from DCC. Mrs Tamlyn commented that the cost of £520.33 did not seem to reflect the amount for the work that was agreed as road marking of 30mph should have been included. Cllr Mrs Davis said she will investigate and notify the Clerk who will again contact SWH.

Mrs Tamlyn asked if the Parish Agendas could be placed on the Marwood website. The Clerk said this will be done.

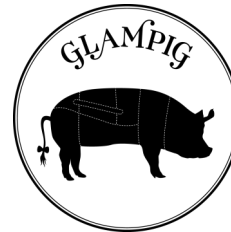
