



Saveourpub Group Update

In July, as a consequence of our nomination, North Devon Council (NDC) took the decision that the Ring O'Bells, Prixford, Barnstaple, EX31 4DX should be entered on the council's Register of Assets of Community Value.

NDC advised us in August that they had been notified "by the owner of the Ring O'Bells, Prixford that he intends to instigate a relevant disposal of the asset.... As the nominating group you now have this 6 week period to decide if you wish to bid for the asset. If you do, the full moratorium period of 6 months will be activated which enables the group to develop a business plan and finance."

A meeting was called at short notice with approximately 40 people attending and a unanimous decision was taken (10 people unable to attend emailed their agreement) to respond to the Council expressing an interest and activating the 6 month period.

David Baker and Jonny Argent have agreed to lead the next phase of the saveourpub campaign.

Marwood Community Hall Charity

The AGM of the Marwood Community Hall Charity was held on July 16th: 34 people attended of whom 28 were eligible to vote. The four former Trustees did not seek re-election. The names of new Trustees and new representatives from local groups were put forward. Alan Cruden and Pete Silveston were subsequently elected as the new Elected Members and at the meeting five new Representative Members were appointed: Corinne Lethaby for the Marwood School Association, Liz Quick for the Marwood Toddlers, Sam Wallis for the Marwood Pre-School, Brian Chugg for the Marwood Methodist Church and Cllr Richard May for the Marwood Parish Council. The Elected and Representative Members are the new trustees for the Hall Charity and together form the Management Committee. Subsequent to the AGM the new Management Committee unanimously appointed two Additional Representative Members: Margaret Greenslade for the Parochial Church Council and Margaret Pover for the Marwood Ladies. In addition Alun Cruden was appointed Chair, Liz Quick Vice-Chair and Pete Silveston Secretary/Treasurer.

At the AGM a statement was read which had been prepared by the out-going Trustees stating that it had been agreed in principle, by a majority decision, to recommend the building of a new Community Hall at the Marwood School site. The recommendation was subject to an acceptable Management Agreement and the confirmation from Devon County Council (DCC) that the road at the side of the school can be used as the access to the new Community Hall.

At the first meeting of the new Management Committee on July 22nd there was unanimous agreement to proceed with the recommendation to build the new Community Hall on the school site and the need to resolve the conditions placed on the recommendation by the previous Trustees.

Understanding the position of DCC on a number of points is the critical next step and this will be the focus of action in the coming weeks. The intention is to provide an update of project progress in Marwood Matters on a regular basis.

Parish Council Report

Report of Parish Council Meeting 11 July 2013

Present: Cllrs J Glanville, C Latham, C Spear

Apologies: Cllrs Mrs S Darling, G Tamlyn, R May, C Wallis, T Bigge. Cllr Mrs A Davis

In Attendance: Dist Cllr J Tucker. M J Measures
Nine members of the public. In the absence of Cllr Mrs Darling, Cllr C Latham took the meeting.

Minutes: The Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting 18 June were agreed and signed as a true record with one minor amendment.

County and District Councillors Reports: The Parish Council congratulated Cllr Mrs Davis on her appointment as Chairman of Exmoor National Park. The Clerk read from her report, including: DCC Appeal to about 4000 National Bus-Pass holders to get in touch as many potentially may be without an updated pass; Research has shown that 2% of families suffer significant multiple problems; DCC is more than half-way through this year's road dressing programme.

Correspondence: The Clerk reported that he had received an e-mail from NDC concerning the application from an unincorporated local community group under the Community Right to Bid. NDC confirmed that the Ring O' Bells, Prieford should be entered on the NDC Register of Assets of Community Value. Standing Orders were suspended to allow a member of the public to speak concerning the numerous occasions heavy traffic has caused damage to property in Kings Heanton. Standing Orders were reinstated and Cllr Latham said he will contact DCC Highways and that the Clerk will write to Cllr Mrs Davis requesting that signs should be erected stating "no access for heavy goods vehicles" or "road-width restrictions".

Planning Applications: 55881 Marwood House. Listed building application for alteration to balcony to form enclosed porch.

Recommend: Approval.

55898 Hewish Cottages, Muddiford. Change of Use of agricultural land to form domestic cartilage.

Recommend: Approval.

55734 Land at Hartland View Farm. Erection of one wind turbine. Standing Orders were suspended to allow members of the public to speak. The applicant and agent were present and the agent read a short presentation in support of the application. Two members of the public spoke in opposition. Cllr Spear said he could support the application if it only generated power for the farm. Standing Orders were reinstated and Cllr Spear recommended the application be refused. The vote taken for refusal was FOR 2, AGAINST 1. **Recommend: Refusal**

Finance: Balance at 11 July was £9254.58 (includes P3 funds to be used next month)

The AGM of the Community Hall Charity will be held on 16 July. Members agreed, that if asked, the Parish Council should continue to manage the funds.

Reports from Councillors: In the absence of Cllr Wallis, the Clerk reported that bridleway 28 will be closed from 15-19 July to carry long-awaited repairs. Chairman's Discretion: After numerous telephone calls and e-mails, the Clerk has now obtained the programme for the Parish Lengthsmen. Councillors should let him know of possible work as the next dates for Marwood are 29/30 July.
