4935. Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting 10 January 2019

Minutes were agreed and signed as a true record.

4936. Police Report

The Clerk sent Members a copy of the Police Report which showed one crime of criminal assault reported in the Marwood area.

4937. Reports from County and District Councillors

Cllr Mrs Davis had sent her report which the clerk read to Members.

Waste Transfer. A new waste transfer station at Brynsworthy became fully operational on 11 February 2019. The facility enables Devon County Council to “bulk-up” waste away from landfill where it will be converted into electricity. It marks the end to landfilling of residential household “black bag” waste in the County of Devon.

North Devon Link Road. Permission has been granted to upgrade 11km of the road as part of the £93m scheme. Work is due to start in Spring 2021.

Recycling Awards. People can vote for their “People's Choice Recycling Hero”.

B3230 Muddiford Speed Survey. This was carried out after the road closure and the results show an average speed of 28.2mph.(A copy of the full report is attached to the Minutes)

Highways/Transport. Cllr Spear commented on the high speed of traffic on the stretch of road within the 30mph limit from the village green going towards Bittadon. The Clerk was asked to bring this to the attention of the Crime and Police Commissioner in an attempt to installing some form of speed restrictions.
