It has been great to have a busy Autumn term at Marwood SchooL. Children have been learning well in classrooms and our new reading books are enjoyed by all readers. Everyone at school is grateful for the £2200 donation of funds from the Marwood School Association to help purchase more books.

We have been able to return to more usual events since September. For example:

- Class 3 have completed 6 swimming sessions at Ilfracombe Pool and had a Stone Age history day at Kents Cavern Torquay.
- Class 4 enjoyed a 2 night residential at Ultimate Adventure, Abbotsham in some fantastic October weather.

In the spring we are looking forward to Volleyball and Basketball sessions at Braunton Academy and gymnastics in Barnstaple for our younger children

The guidance is very much that children without Covid who are well should be at school. All at school are working to keep our Covid Secure hygiene and ventilation measures in place.
