Construction News

On 21st November 2022 our team will be working overnight moving the traffic management system at Borners Bridge Junction

The closure will be from 8pm to 6am. Diversion route maps are below for the northern diversion and on Page 2 for the Southern Diversion.

For local traffic in the North Molton area, neighbouring villages and hamlets residents will be aware of local roads to use to access or cross the A361. The official diversion route north of Borners Bridge will be signed for larger vehicles or those unfamiliar with the area during the closure. Please see the map below. We shall be contacting local businesses immediately north of Borners Bridge separately to explain the limited closure and diversion routes. Apologies for any inconvenience caused.



Skate Molton Market Sessions are confirmed!!


Every Tuesday starting from 18/10/22 5pm-6pm SEN session (Booking required)
